

Martial Arts TV Chatroom & Message Board Services

This is the code of conduct that you must adhere to when using our chatroom and message board services.

As part of our service to you we provide various message board and chatroom facilities (the "Service"). By using the Service, you agree to abide by this code of conduct. Martial Arts TV's Website Terms and Conditions also apply to your use of the Service, and you should read them before continuing.

If you do not adhere to this code of conduct, we reserve the right to terminate your use of the Service and/or to remove any content placed by you on this website. We reserve the right to take such action without first notifying you of our intention to do so.

The Code of Conduct

You agree to abide by the following code of conduct when using the Service.

We provide the Service to you solely for your personal, private use. You undertake not to use the Service:

- (a) for any unlawful purpose;

- (h) to transmit any material for the purposes of publicity, promotion and/or advertising without our prior written consent unless such transmission has been specifically requested by another user of the Service;
- (i) to create a false identity for the purpose of misleading others as to the

identity of the sender or the origin of a message, including, but not limited to impersonating an Martial Arts TV employee, manager, host or another user; or

(j) to transmit, upload, post or otherwise make available any solicited or unauthorised advertising, promotional materials, "junk mail", "spam", "chain letters", "pyramid schemes" or any duplicative or unsolicited messages.
